☞ **Dr. Anne Livingston, Haiti:** After her hip replacement in January, Dr. Anne had planned to return to the field at the end of March. You may remember, however, that the situation in Haiti was very unstable at that time, and she has had to postpone her trip back several times. Even now, things are still not good, and she gives us this report: *"My workers report shortages for everything, and there are rumors of possible serious problems on May 18 (Haitian Flag Day). While they would like for me to return, and patients say they want me back, the advice right now is to wait until the end of June. I have rescheduled my flight for June 25...please continue to pray for the people of Haiti, and for me to have wisdom for future plans. Praise God, He is in control!"*
