Faith Overcoming Fear

What keeps a believer from sharing the gospel? Rather than a lack of know-how, it more often can be a lack of courage. You, like I, may not have the most out-going personality. Here are some principles I find helpful in overcoming the fear of being rejected.

- **1. Expect opposition.** Jesus said, "They have persecuted Me, they will also persecute you" (John 15:20).
- **2. Pray,** and ask others to pray for you. "[Pray] for me, that utterance (words) may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel" (Ephesians 6:19).
- **3. Expect ridicule.** "We are [looked upon as] fools for Christ's sake" (I Corinthians 4:10).
- **4. Determine to please the Lord, not people.** "We ought to obey God rather than men" (Acts 5:29).
- **5.** Consider what's at stake. "He that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him" (John 3:36). "He that heareth My word, and believeth on Him that sent Me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life" (John 5:24).
- C.H. Spurgeon testified, "Even if I were utterly selfish and had no care for anything but my own happiness, I would choose to be a soul-winner. Never did I know perfect, overflowing, unutterable happiness till I first heard of one who had sought and found the Savior through my means. No young mother ever so rejoiced over her firstborn child. No warrior was so exultant over a hard-won victory."
