What Will You Leave Behind?

Many parents today are concerned about what they will leave behind for their children. While there is nothing wrong with leaving material possessions behind for our children, it can be easy to forget that the greatest legacy we can leave is a godly heritage.

In Judges 2:10, we see the importance of a godly heritage: “...*there arose another generation after them, which knew not the Lord, nor yet the works which he had done for Israel.*”

The previous generation did not tell the children about the person of the Lord. They failed to keep the reality of who God is in front of their children. While the previous generation may have talked some about God, it seems they did not make an intentional effort to do so with their children. Are we consistently talking to our children about Who our God is on a regular basis?

The previous generation also failed to tell their children about the works of God. God had done many miracles for the children of Israel, but their children did not seem to know much about what God had done for them. We must be intentional in our efforts to tell our children about what God has done and how amazing the works of our God are in our daily lives.

The book of Judges recounts the struggles of a generation that did not have a godly heritage. We must be purposeful in telling our children about the person and work of our great God.
