Living for Eternity

Throughout the Bible, we find word pictures that illustrate principles God wants us to understand and apply to our lives. In James 4, God uses the picture of vapor to illustrate the shortness of life. In this winter season, we know it’s cold out when we can see our breath. But that vapor doesn’t linger long; it’s gone as quickly as it comes. In the grand scheme of things, life is like that – brief and fleeting.

But we don’t always remember that. We generally feel that our time here on earth will be long, and, too often, we fail to keep eternity in mind. But when someone’s life is cut short unexpectedly, we are reminded of the brevity of life and the importance of living for Christ completely in the time that we do have.

Last weekend, my wife and I attended the funeral of a college friend and were confronted with the truth that life can sometimes be much shorter than we plan. What we should do for the Lord, we must do now. Even though God has given us many things on earth to enjoy, we are not to live for those temporal things. Our lives are to be lived for God’s glory and honor by bearing fruit for Him.

What would be said of your life if God suddenly called you home? May it be said of each of us that we served Christ faithfully, with eternity in view.
