☞ **Jeff & Linda Brown, retired from Germany**, write, "We have been deeply concerned at the rise of antisemitism in American universities. In our 31 years of life in Germany, we informed ourselves very well about the rise of Nazi power and its deadly antisemitism. We recognize the exact same thing is happening now in our homeland. One of the first places that Nazism and antisemitism gained a foothold in the 1930s was in the universities of Germany. We were thankful that, using Scripture, we were able to inform the college-age class of our church about this problem, particularly using Proverbs 24:10-12. We let them know that many Christians in Germany in those days looked the other way and later said exactly what Proverbs quotes, "We did not know." We challenged the young people that the time has now come for them, and they will be responsible to speak up for the Jewish people in America. We pray both for Israel and for our own nation."
