Another Generation

In Judges 2:10, we find one of the most troubling verses in all of the Bible. It says, "And also all that generation were gathered unto their fathers: and there arose another generation after them, which knew not the LORD, nor yet the works which he had done for Israel." How sad it is that this verse paints a very dismal picture of a doomed generation.

The book of Judges goes on to tell the sad cycle of sin, enslavement, repentance, and short reprieve that the people of Israel experienced during these dark days of her history. But why did this take place? They were finally in the land of promise. God had done wonderful things for Israel during the years of conquest under capable leaders such as Joshua. The fault lies in the generation that preceded the generation that had never experienced first-hand the wonderful works of God. They did not pass along the knowledge of God to the next generation. This, of course, led to all of the sorrow and problems associated with the following generations.

Another verse in the Bible says, "*Tell ye your children of it, and let your children tell their children, and their children another generation*" (Joel 1:3). This is how we ensure that there is not "another generation" that does not know the Lord. We must continue to pray, serve, tell, and give so that the generations to come might see the wondrous works of our mighty God.
