Anniversary Sunday

Today marks the 61st anniversary of Grace Baptist Church. On the first Sunday in April, 1963, the small church plant, led by Pastor Art Guetterman, approved a constitution and by-laws that officially inaugurated the Grace Baptist Church of Muncie, IN. What that small group prayerfully and sacrificially began would continue to grow, and, in 1967, after Pastor Guetterman joined the military chaplaincy, Dr. Collins Glenn was called to pastor the church. He, along with his wife and two children, moved to Muncie, and God used him greatly for 45 years.
